RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TOQUERVILLE CITY, UTAH ("CITY"), PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF JUNE 19-25, 2023 TO BE AMATEUR RADIO WEEK.

PREAMBLE
